Primary Responsibilities:

- C. Assist with M&A advisory, structured finance and other strategic transactions.
- D. Structuring, negotiation and documentation drafting/review for the relevant coverage areas, such as corporate financing, investment advisory.
- E. Creation and maintenance of standard contract documentation for transactions.
- F. Participate in meetings with other departments, Head Office for various projects.
- G. Development and maintenance of efficient and effective relationships with outside counsels.

- B. 3 years of experience in corporate finance and/or securities regulations (including time spent with a law firm or as in-house counsel to a financial institution).
